Safety Flash

Incident with Recordable Injury

Date of Incident: 9/23/2020

The Incident

An associate was using an approved wire stripping device to remove the outer coat of a traycable. The blade of the device slipped off the cable and cut the associate's leg, resulting in OSHA recordable medical treatment.

The Causes

- The cold cable jacket made it tougher to cut.
- Body positioning/line of fire
- Tight work area

Prevent It

- Use correct body positioning stay out of the line of fire.
- Control temperature if possible to keep the outer coat pliable.
- Warm the cable itself if temperature control is not possible.

Action Plan

• A safety stand-down is to be performed with the entire work crew to discuss the findings of this incident review.
