

Safety Flash

Incident with Recordable Injury

Date of Incident: 2/20/2025

The Incident

Associate was returning to work after lunch entering through an unauthorized access point which was covered with a sheet of visqueen. When the Associate #1 made entrance, Associate #2 was utilizing a push broom which came in contact with Associate #1's left foot, causing them to jump out of the way of the broom and slip on ice. This resulted in Associate #1 falling onto the concrete slab.

The Causes

- Utilizing unathorized access point.
- Lack of a site plan that designated safe walking paths.
- Presence of ice on walking/working surfaces.
- · Lack of visibility when entering a work area.

Prevent It

- Unauthorized access point was eliminated by placing barricades around the area where the associate was injured.
- Ice was removed on walking/working surfaces.

Action Plan

- Site plan was requested to identify safe walking paths.
- Stand-down with all crews to be held and cover this information.
- Safety Flash to be distributed company wide for a "Lessons Learned".
